
ATV Trails set to open May 15th

We are on target for trail opening on May 15th. The winter storms provided some additional work this spring to clear trails of downed trees and repair some trail washouts. Some snow-covered sections of the trail remain into early May. Club Trail Coordinators and 25 club volunteers have contributed 140 hours inspecting the 72 miles of trail, removing downed trees, and working with townships and contractors to repair washouts. The eastern section of the Emily Blind Lake trail, from Crow Wing Cty. Rd 106 east of the Blind Lake Connector Trail will remain closed until sometime after May 24th. We need local road restrictions to be lifted, to bring in fill before a large washout can be repaired on the Lenz Road. A temporary reroute using Cty. Rd 106 and Cty. Rd. 1 can be used to access the Blind Lake Connector Trail.

Check the DNR website for trail closures before heading out.

2023 Pork N Ride is June 10th


Our most popular event of the year is happening soon!


