

Riding with Rory

The 2nd Annual Riding with Rory and "Dart To Awareness" fundraiser is all about



bringing awareness to the subject of suicide. We feel this is a topic people would like to ignore or forget in hopes that it will go away. Rory is club member Karla's 17 year old son who was lost to suicide June 24, 2021. In April, 2022 his best friend died the same way. Karla started this ride as a memorial to Rory who loved wheelers and the outdoors. We want to help the family raise money to be

able to give 2 scholarships away; 1 to the Aitkin School and 1 to the Crosby School for a student entering a trade program. The remaining funds will go to the CAPS program in Aitkin. CAPS helps bring suicide awareness to our small communities. We will have various handouts for mental health available. T-shirts will be available to purchase for \$25 with \$10 from each purchase being donated towards the scholarships. The ride starts at 10am at the Log Cabin Bar in Emily, MN and all experience levels of riders are welcome.

There is no cost to ride. Pre-registration is not required but does help with planning. Thank You!



Safety and Trail Updates

OTHG Trail Coordinator Report for 8/5/2023

Perry reported culvert damage on Lens Road to Ross Lake Township Perry spoke with Crow Wing County on possible wetland violations and private property encroachment on EBL. Perry spoke with Terry regarding JM work on EBL

Made a verbal agreement with Enbridge on repair of "A" trail leading up to Wren Lake Loop (No new progress) Perry to prepare bid requests.

Terry ordered fill and spread near driveway south of Emily City Hall Terry interviewed possible new trail company (Ruyak Enterprises)

Terry issued new work to JM on ditching, widening, and repairs to "B" trail.

Kent graded "A" trail from Papoose Road to Outing

Perry provided additional signs to Dales Prop Shop to install on Bloomquist Drive Meri Lysne requested more "Outing" signs on trail.

Perry to attend Crooked Lake Town Board meeting on August 7, regarding Sunset Hill Road

Terry working on Hwy 6 ditch work north of Pickled Loon in mid-September. New gravel/crushed asphalt needed on the trail by the Emily City Hall Entrance
