Past Events:

9th Annual Exploring MN Ride, Saturday August 17th, 2024. This ride brought the Cuyuna Iron Range Riders and the Over the Hills Gang ATV Clubs to the Wilderness Trail

located in Itasca County. This annual ride seeks to bring club members to trails around Minnesota, exploring the diversity of our 80 great Grant-in-Aid ATV trails, the local government units that sponsor the trail, and the ATV clubs that help maintain the trail. Itasca County is one of Minnesota's ATV Recreation leaders, building trails that connect to communities both within and outside of county lines, and this year hosting the ATV MN Ride & Rally.

Our group began the day by meeting at a large parking area in Talmoon, MN next to Hayslips Corner. We headed west, then north through well maintained national forest roads. The tree canopy made up of hardwoods and pines provided a scenic and shady ride, with many views of lakes in the area. There were numerous off-route trails that were open to ATV's, however, we primarily stayed on the designated mapped route.

In total, 19 machines rode 75-miles on a wonderful August day enjoying the Wilderness Trail



Pizza Party Ride

Trail Updates









feature for the Emily Outing ATV Trail is the construction of a new Crow Wing County Park called Little Emily Lake Park. Located on the AB Trail section, this park offers a pavilion with picnic tables, vault toilets, playground, fishing pier, swim beach, walking paths, carry-in launch sites for a kayak or canoe, plenty of parking for vehicles which includes an ATV truck & trailer parking area. The park was dedicated on August 8th, and open for visitors. For the 20,000 plus ATV's that annually use our trail, this will

definitely be a new destination stop.

Grant Manager Report

In 2023, the Northwoods Regional ATV Trail System received a \$250,000 grant from the MN DNR ATV Dedicated account to be used to repair or refurbish sections of the Northwood's 500-mile trail system. As a member club of the Northwoods Regional ATV Trail Alliance, the OTHG ATV Club received 10% or \$25,000 of this grant. We chose to apply these funds to repair our "A" Trail from Sunset Hill Road north to the Moose River Trails. This section of trail was physically sinking, or being compacted below the adjacent land surfaces, which

caused standing water on 50% of the trail. It also resulted in adjacent swamps to flood the trail during wet periods of weather. Our club had this section closed from May 28th to August 3rd due to soft soil conditions. We have a applied a trail building technique, ditching each side of the trail, placing the excavated materials on top of the trail, which raised the trail bed 2-3 feet. The trail now needs to dry, densify and compact before final grading. Currently, this section is in a rough-in stage with a narrow trail surface and deep ditches. We can assure you, this will be only a temporary situation until final grading, and the natural vegetation grows back.





One of our missions for our club is to promote ATV Safety, especially for children. Here are a few statistics that highlights this mission

In the US there have been over 4,000 children 15 years of age and under who have been fatally injured in ATV or UTV accidents since 1982.

- In 9 of 10 fatalities, the victim is not wearing a helmet.
- In 95% of fatalities the victim had not received safety certification.
- 92-97% of child ATV / UTV related fatalities, the child is on an adult-sized machine.
- 63% of all fatalities are due to rollovers
- 70% happen in the right of way.

The data concerning injuries is alarming. According to the American Academy of Pediatrics, 40,000 to 55,000 children are visiting Emergency Rooms each year, due to ATV/ UTV related injuries. 27% of these require hospitalization and can involve multisystem injuries including traumatic brain injury (leading cause of fatality), broken bones, internal organ injuries, spinal cord injuries, paralysis, burns, and amputations.

For children under 18, wearing a DOT approved helmet is the law as an ATV operator or passenger.

A MN ATV Safety Certificate is also mandatory for anyone born after July 1, 1987 and is at least 12 year of age to operate an ATV on public trails.
