Trails Opening



OTHG Maintained ATV Trails open May 15, 2025

Each year we are asked when our ATV trails open. For the Emily Outing/ Moose River Trails and the Emily Blind Lake ATV Trail, this date is May 15, 2025. Why???

- 1. Our trail crosses many land-managed jurisdictions such as: Crooked Lake, Beulah, Smoky Hollow, Fairfield, Ross Lake, & Little Pine townships, City of Emily, Cass, Crow Wing & Aitkin County lands, MNDOT Right of Way, Land O Lakes, and Emily State Forest and a few private properties. With each of these land managers, the club asked for a permit, or a public resolution to open our trails on May 15th. As you can see, changing this date, and getting agreement from all land managers on a new date would be difficult
- 2. When we constructed the Emily Blind Lake Trail to the Aitkin County Trails, we also agreed with Aitkin County to match their trail opening date of May 15th.
- 3. Soils across the state are different. Sandy soils tend to warm quicker and provide better drainage for snow melt and early spring rain. Our area soils tend to have more clay content, which slows drainage, and holds the ground frost longer. In 2024, frost was still in the ground on Memorial weekend in some trail sections, which resulted in damage to our trail and a future trail section closure.

We communicate with the DNR and our county sponsors on a regular basis, and the best place to look for Off-Highway Vehicle closures is here. Our club Vice President, Rod Wegner also does a great job making posts on our club Facebook page, regarding trail closures for ATV trails our club maintains.

Just a note. We (DNR+Club+Local Govt Sponsor) can always delay trail opening or close trails due to poor soil conditions, timber harvests, damages or unsafe trails.

The management of the Club is vested in the Board of Directors which includes the Secretary. The Secretary works with the other Board of Director volunteers to discuss overall direction and operation of the Club. The Secretary has oversight of the By-Laws Committee and Nomination Committee. Additionally, the Secretary keeps all club records including minutes of meetings, roster of club members, list of committees and their members.

Invasive Terrestrial Species & Play/Clean/Go



Invasive Terrestrial Species & Play/Clean/Go

I recently attended a DNR meeting at Park Rapids, Mn for clubs that maintain recreational trails in the Northwest Region. One of the informative discussion topics was regarding invasive species which are hitching a ride via our ATV's in and around our forests. These invasives can include the Common Tansy, Garlic Mustard, Leafy Spurge, Common Buckthorn, Wild Parsnip, and Spotted Knapweed. Invasive species have many ways of spreading, including human activity. For instance, invasive plants store seeds in the soil, so muddy boots or muddy vehicles can carry them to new areas in their tread. Some invasive plant seeds have special hooks to help them hitch a ride. This enables invasive plant seeds to hitch a ride on our shoes, socks, pants, and shirts. As a club we are going to take some education initiatives for riders on our trails, such as informative signs at parking /meeting areas, brochures, and possibly looking into a wash station. Secondly, increasing our ability to identify an invasive will help us direct resources to kill these invasives before they spread more. Keep our forests clean!
