Spring Trail Work Begins



Spring Trail Work Begins

Thanks to over 30 volunteers who rode and inspected the trails on May 4th, we compiled a large list of trail issues and improvements needed to get done during the 2025 riding season. Volunteers removed down trees, cut back overhanging brush, made notes of missing or damaged signs, and marked damaged culverts for replacement. The 70-miles of trails that the OTHG manages were all certified to open on May 15, 2025.

Larger trail projects consist of repairs to our south Emily boardwalk, new culverts for sections of our "A" & "B" trails, crowing, trail hardening, and signage for our new trail section by Little Emily Lake County Park, and grading and crowing sections of trail flattened out by winter timber harvests. later this summer we will have an effort to improve the south side of the Moose River Wren Lake and Cedar Lake loop trails.

There will be some new additions to our trails also, such as a few new benches on trail stop areas, a new porta-potty near Little Reservoir Lake just off the Pikus Forest Road, and a new grill and charcoal ash box donated to us by the North Metro Trail Riders. We also are the first club in Minnesota working directly with the MN DNR to identify invasive plant species along our trails. *Save the day of July 18, 2025* for a small classroom and field training to help us identify some of these plants as we ride. More information coming soon.

Member Questions This Month



Member Q&A This Month:

Q. Are OHM's allowed on the OTHG Trails?

A. OHM stands for Off-Highway Motorcycle. They are allowed on the Emily Blind Lake Trail (Crow Wing & Aitkin County), but not allowed on the Emily Outing & Moose River Trails (Cass County)

Q. Can a SxS ride on the OTHG Trails?

A. SxS stands for side by side seating. Our trails are open to Class I and Class II ATV's. If your side by side seating ATV is under 2000 lbs, dry weight and between 50 and 65 inches in width you have a Class II ATV. Class I ATV's are under 50 inches and typically are saddle type seating.

Q. What happened to the AB Trail?

A. With the new trail reroute near Little Emily Lake County Park, the AB trail was merged into the "A" trail. Our 2025 paper maps, and Polaris Ride Command is updated to reflect this change.

Q. What happened to the kiosk in the Pickled Loon Parking lot?

A. The kiosk along with the parking area was moved 1 mile east of the Pickled Loon, across MN Hwy 6, and down Papoose Road, next to the new Little Emily Lake County Park. The new parking area is spacious, and eliminates the need for riders crossing MN Hwy 6 to access the trails.

ATV Safety Training

On Saturday, May 3, 2025 the Over the Hills Gang



ATV Club facilitated ATV Safety Training. Thirty students completed both their online and hands-on training which is needed to receive their ATV Safety Certificate once they turn 12 years of age. Anyone born after July 1, 1987 is required by state law to have a Minnesota ATV Safety Certificate to ride public trails. Annual safety statistics confirm that children and adults that have completed safety training and achieved a certificate are the safest riders on the trails. Many thanks to our volunteer Certified Safety Instructors who facilitated this training including Cindy & Dave Thompson, Lynn Remington, Perry May, Kathie & Ryan Huettl, Jim & Brenda Anderson, Terry & Becky Tuckenhagen, Ken Irish, Dave Kodada, Tim Sink, and Conservation Officer Jacquelin Johnson.

On Friday May 17th, the Over the Hills Gang and Eagle Country Snowmobile & ATV Club helped facilitate the outdoor portion of ATV Safety Training for the 5th grade class at Remer Schools. Conservation Officer Corey Sura led the indoor portion of the training. Seventeen students completed their work for an ATV Safety Certificate.
